All Staff & Volunteers

- **Level 1 Safeguarding Everyone** – Introduction to safeguarding, helping you recognise concerns and understand your responsibilities.
- **Level 2 Safeguarding Everyone** – Builds on Level 1 with detail on identifying and responding to risks.
- **Online Safety (E-Safety)** – Covers risks in digital environments and how to keep people safe online.
- **Radicalisation and Extremism (Prevent)** – Identify signs of radicalisation and understand Prevent duties.
- **Modern Slavery and Trafficking** – Explains indicators of exploitation and how to respond appropriately.
- **Awareness of Forced Marriages** – Identifies warning signs and safeguarding responses to forced marriage.
- **LGBTQ+ Awareness** – Promotes inclusive practice and understanding of specific vulnerabilities.
- **Understanding the Impacts of Hate Crime** – Explores how hate incidents affect individuals and communities.
- **Child Poverty** – Examines how poverty impacts wellbeing and safeguarding risk.
- **Safer Working Practices** – Guidance on maintaining safe, professional conduct in your role.
- **Learning from Child Safeguarding Practice Reviews** – Uses real cases to improve safeguarding practice.

Children & Young People

- **Level 2 Safeguarding Children** – Core knowledge for recognising and responding to child safeguarding concerns.
- **Level 2 Safeguarding Children Refresher** – Updates and reinforces existing safeguarding knowledge.
- **Level 3 Safeguarding Children** – Advanced safeguarding for those working closely with children and families.
- **Level 3 Safeguarding Children Refresher** – Keeps advanced safeguarding knowledge current.
- **Attachment and Child Development** – Explains how early relationships impact development and behaviour.
- **Supporting Teenagers and Young People** – Focuses on risks and support strategies for adolescents.
- **Understanding Young Minds** – Explores children and young people's mental health and wellbeing.
- **Working with Individuals with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND)** – Addresses additional safeguarding needs and risks.
- **Safer Sleeping for Babies** – Promotes safe sleep practices to reduce risk of infant harm.
- **Child Criminal Exploitation, Gangs and County Lines** – Identifies signs of exploitation linked to criminal activity.
- **Child Exploitation and Extra-familial Harm** – Covers risks outside the home, including peer and community harm.
- **Fabricated Illness** – Helps recognise when illness may be induced or exaggerated by a carer.
- **Misogyny Awareness: Children and Young people** – Identify misogynistic behaviour and tackle those behaviours appropriately.
- **Understanding Female Genital Mutilation** – Learn how to spot the signs and protect women and girls.
- **FGM (Abuse Linked to Faith or Belief)** – Explores cultural context and safeguarding responses to FGM.
- **Parental Domestic Abuse, Substance Misuse and Parental Mental Illness** – Explains how parental factors impact children's safety.
- **Safeguarding in Education** – Applies safeguarding principles within school settings.
- **Safeguarding in Sport** – Focuses on safeguarding responsibilities in sporting environments.
- **Safeguarding in the Children's Workforce** – Broad safeguarding responsibilities across children's services.
- **Understanding the Importance of Primary Behaviour Support** – Promotes positive behaviour approaches to reduce risk.
